

Greetings,

It's hard to believe that the year is almost over. It is a privilege to say that STGMA is growing! We are gaining new Sponsor Churches and welcoming back some previous Members just in the last few weeks. As we move into 2016, we anticipate even more growth. It's an exciting time!

As a Christian, we're commanded in Mark 16:15 to "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature". With no time to lose, we must increase our efforts in every way possible. We recognize that with growth comes change, however, our mission remains the same: To spread the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ through music and song. The efforts of STGMA to accomplish this have been sufficient up to this point but I believe we can all agree that there is always room for improvement. After much prayer and seeking direction from the Lord, the Board and Officers have chosen to implement the following improvements.

- 1) Beginning January 2016, we will have a concert every other month (for a total of 6). The Board is working to determine the churches that will participate. There will be a maximum of three (3) Artists at each event. We will be asking each church to host the event on the 4th Saturday of the month if at all possible. Once the dates and churches are confirmed, we will contact our Artists regarding availability. Each concert will be on a love offering basis distributed equally among the Artists (soloist, duo, trio or group).
- 2) Convention is tentatively scheduled for April and more details will be provided at a later date so Artists can "save the date". You will NOT want to miss this one!
- 3) We have reduced the STGMA fund-raising to one event only. It will be held sometime in the fall and additional information will be provided once the details are finalized. We are open to suggestions for how to raise funds (i.e., auction or other community participation ideas).

With the momentum growing and excitement flowing, I can assure you that your STGMA Board and Officers are working very hard to strengthen our relationships with current sponsor churches as well as introducing STGMA to additional churches so we can build a bond with them. If you have a church that you think we should contact, let us know! The more churches we can connect with...the more opportunities you may have to minister!







STGMA is so excited to welcome back our good friends, **The Bethels**. This ladies trio will bless your heart with their family harmony and sweet spirit.

We have many folks in the Association that have joined and never really had an opportunity to have the purpose of STGMA explained. So, here is an overview.

STGMA has three ways to support our mission statement "to spread the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ through music and song."

- The first way is to contact our Sponsor Churches (through the Pastor and/or Music Minister) and coordinate one or more singings each year. They agree to host at least one as a Sponsor Church.
- 2. We encourage Members (singers, musicians and other supporters of gospel music) to come together in one accord to worship the Lord and minister to hurting hearts and lost souls.
- 3. STGMA is not a booking agency, however, our most effective way of supporting the ministries of our Members is to (whenever possible) assist in connecting performing Members with Sponsor Churches when they have events in the San Antonio and surrounding areas.

In other words, Sponsor Churches will be encouraged by the Board and Officers to view the information about all our Members on our STGMA website, select who they want to invite to <u>special events</u> held at their church and then contact STGMA directly to coordinate the specific details such as determining the date/time. Once the date is confirmed, the performing Member will need to email all the information about the event to Christine to get it announced on the STGMA.org website schedule.

A love offering from the participating Church will go directly to the performing Member and will no longer go through STGMA simply because we no longer want to limit what God wants to do to bless your ministry. The STGMA Board will be your biggest prayer warriors and will strive to consistently follow the leadership of the Spirit in determining the path forward.

### MINISTRY MOMENTS

There are so many times that Hearts of Grace has the opportunity to pray with folks who are hurting and we have been blessed to lead many to a knowledge of Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. No greater feeling than walking someone into the blessing of having Heaven as their home one day after awhile. Christine and I hosted the 1st Annual "Traveling with Grace" cruise to Mexico last month featuring Appointed By Grace and Hearts of Grace and were blessed to have 50+ guests onboard. We have participated in cruises for over 5 years, but this was the first as an extension of our ministry. Here is an example from Christine about one opportunity God gave us during the trip.

Folks, I can't even begin to tell you all the 'God Moments' we experienced during the six days we were on the ship, but I'd like to share this one encounter in particular. We were on the Triumph and Carnival has a rule that a 'Private Function' sign must be placed outside the door when small group events are held. What that basically means is that we could not 'advertise' the singing in the Carnival brochure they leave in each cabin nor invite folks to come, but if they came in...we didn't have to ask them to leave. So, as we stepped up to sing the first sea day, a couple came to the door. They saw the 'Private Function' sign, looked inside but turned to leave. But God had a different plan. Though we had not originally intended to sing it, Floyd started the music for Beulah Land and the lady stopped. She opened the door and they both made their way to a seat. I noticed she cried through nearly every song so I approached them when we finished and introduced myself. She introduced herself and her husband and said she "made a wrong turn" but heard her favorite song and had to come listen. I said "No, you made the right turn!" She had just had surgery to remove a tumor from her throat and been diagnosed with trachea cancer...it's very rare. She was going back to the doctor after the cruise so they could determine the path forward because no one was quite sure what to do. She explained that she had been saved for about nine years and her husband for just 4 months. Without skipping a beat, I asked if she would mind if we prayed for her. She said, "Please! I really needed this today." I gathered several folks together and Floyd along with my Mom prayed Heaven down. It was so anointed. We exchanged email addresses and phone numbers because I wanted to hear the doctor's plan for treatment. Our final two singings were on Friday heading home but on Thursday night, our Carnival Representative called our cabin and asked Floyd if it would be okay with us to remove the 'Private Function' sign so anyone could attend! Yep...they called us! Only God could do that...He allowed us to find favor with them and blessed us with a full room of folks listening to the Word in song! Our hearts are full and we are grateful to be vessels God is using. How has He used you through your ministry? Blessings... cjs:)
