THE SUDDEN COMING OF THE LORD...

As things of this world seem to be closing in on us, we to begin to think more and more on this topic. We have many examples in the scripture that talk about it. We may also have thoughts on what this means to us. However, there is no definite or direct answer as we understand it. When the Apostle Paul wrote his first letter to the church at Thessalonica, he wrote these words found in the 4th Chapter verses 13-18. It says "But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with a voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words."

As the Apostle Paul continued in Chapter 5, he said we're just going to have to be patient while we look for His coming. But that does not mean we sit back and do nothing. In verse 9-10 and 14-15, it says "For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ. Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him. Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men. See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men."

How are we to accomplish this great task? Rejoice!

Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it."




